The idea of the project

The project's symbolic name carries the idea of a new beginning and rethinking of youth work, in the context of the forthcoming post pandemic environment (after) and before (before) - our work as youth organizations of a new kind, adapted to the new realities. Unfortunately, the war is also in the picture.

This led to our aims to find a complex solution, aiding the overcoming of professional burnout, demotivation; encouraging personal reflection and looking for internal, base foundations, values and meanings to be articulated in an impactful way with the power of storytelling.



Personal development INNOVATIVE METHODOLOGY

The methodology includes a rich complex of innovative tools, such as experiential learning, coaching, art therapy, theatrical approaches and (digital) storytelling, in search of effective methods to develop the capacity of civil organizations and motivating youth workers for sustainability in the profession. The project is designed to help personal and professional development of the participants and, at the same time, to train them how to implement the complex methodology with regard to different youth groups they work with. The methodology could be adapted and used for reaching different goals - social inclusion, career orientation, etc. because it is based on deeply personal and individual character levels and values.

Selection criteria

1.Youth workers (preferably from the partner organizations' teams) with some experience in the youth sector2.Motivated interest in the topic, especially in personal development and storytelling

3.English language (at least B2 level), free usage

4.Rediness to take part in all planned activities - online and offline

5.Good physical and mental form and readiness for activities in the mountain (some basic mountain equipment will be needed as well!!!)

6.No age limit

7.No administrative fee

8.One of the participants from each partner country has to be from groups with fewer opportunities (facing economical, geographical, social, health or other restraints) - the partners will receive some support to prepare those participants for active inclusion!

Accommodation

Dobrinishte is located around 160 km south of the capital Sofia, near the famous tourist town of Bansko. At the foot of the beautiful Pirin mountains, with a view of Rila and the Rhodopes. Around 3000 people live in the town. In the summer it's very lively, filled with tourists, songs, dance and fun, thanks to the annual folklore festival. The town has an abundance of mineral water and a SPA opportunity.

We have chosen a family hotel complex, away from the centre of the town. <u>"Valentino-2"</u> will be reserved entirely for the project. No outside people will be allowed.

The hotel has courtyards, which will be used for most of our activities - training, as well as eating, informal communication, etc. There is WiFi and the hotel will provide towels.

The accommodation set up is 2-3 people per room.

Travelling

- A comfortable but economic travel option is prefered
- COVID-19 insurance for cancelation (we will cover the travel costs only to participants that take part in the TC)
- Before purchasing the tickets, we have to approve the itinerary
- The arrival day is July 1, 2022 and all the participants have to be in Sofia, the capital city, till 16:00 (4 PM)
- We will organise a bus from Sofia to the venue and back for which we will deduct 40 EUR from the travel budget
- The departure from the venue is on July 9, 2022 and we recommend the participants choose a travel option NOT EARLY IN THE MORNING (after 12 lunchtime is ok).



Reimbursement

All the participants will receive the reimbursement of the travel cost after the training course via bank transfer, when they:

- fill up the standart online questionnaire after the TC
- send all necessary travel documents (first scaned by email and then sent by post)
- complete the follow up activities
- took part to all planned activities

Buying the tickets is after the confirmation by the coordinator



COVID-19 measures

- All partners follow and inform each other about the development of the pandemic, as well as the measures, implemented in different countries. We will act as is most adequate, to ensure a quality implementation of the TC and the safety of the participants.
- At present, participants who have a green certificate for vaccination will be preferred.
- Tickets are purchased by the participants only after confirmation from the coordinator but no earlier than April 15.
- We can not cover any costs regarding COVID tests.
- The personal health insurance of each participant is mandatory. A group insurance will also be made.
