

Each partner is responsible to send 5 participants and 1 team leader. It is vital to select 2 youth workers besides team leader. Overall, the team should consist of 1 team leader, 2 youth workers and 3 young people.

Travel costs

The travel costs will be reimbursed for the cheapest and direct way of transport and only under the condition that the participant will take part in the whole project and provide all the documents. You will receive the reimbursements in your bank accounts. 30 € participation fee will be deducted from the reimbursement for local transportation.
