SENDING ORGANIZATION



JOETZ is a young, open and dynamic nongovernmental youth organizations in Belgium for kids and youngsters from 3 to 30 years old. We develop projects and activities around health promotion, international youth work and social inclusion. We also organise a wide variety of holidays for kids and youngsters and training for youth workers.

JOETZ is mainly a health promoter and works around health through different campaigns and actions. Our actions are varied and we work around mental as well as physical health. We also work around various other topics like environment, gender issues, racism, youth unemployment, etc... Main Objectives

1.To improve the capac<mark>ity,</mark> through offering volunteers variety of learning opportunities;

2. To develop professional skills and competences in areas such as project management, project application writing,organizing events, graphic designing, social media & web-page administration; 3. To promote tolerance among participants and local young people

4. To give volunteers opportunity to establish new relationships and partnerships across countries;

5.To give the organizations involved new perspectives from the participants and expand experience and network to be able to support the Erasmus+/ESC goals in better quality

6.To raise awareness towards Erasmus+ program, particularly about European Solidarity Corps among Georgian young people and main values of European Citizenship

ACTIVITES

1.Project management and project assistance with ongoing and annual projects of ICPI. Volunteers will be actively involved in planning and organizing of local and international projects.

2. Volunteers will have the chance to gain the knowledge and experience to organize Erasmus + projects (TC, YE) with local coordinator of Erasmus+; They will learn to write applications, to communicate with project partners, to implement project itself.

3. Working on visibility and promotion of ICPI -Volunteers will assist staff of ICPI with web development and PR activities of the organization. All activities will be evaluated regularly to find out how the content complies with participants learning goals and if any adjustments in the daily activities are needed. The participants will be encouraged to propose their own activities or ways to get involved in order to use fully their potential and develop it the desired way.

ACTIVITES

5. Empowering Georgian youngsters and elderly people Volunteers with Local interns will plan and organize workshops/seminars for youngsters and elderly people in different regions twice a month.

6. Volunteers will also have an opportunity to create and lead projects in their fields of interest. If it will be needed there will be interns from ICPI staff being in charge with them to support with Organizational part (language barrier, communicating with local media).Volunteers are free to choose the topic of their personal project and work on it during all the service or plan it in one particular month.

7. Weekly activities of Generator 9.8 - activities in different regions of ICPI has its own social enterprise Generator 9.8 and we are ready to involve our participants in this project as well, they will be assisted by the local volunteers and they will get support from coordinator/ex-EVS volunteers, having experience in the field.

8. Outdoor Activities - ICPI has been organizing various outdoor Georgia. Volunteers will have opportunity to be actively invovled in organizing and implementation.

-Organizing public meet-ups for 18+ youngsters -Co-facilitating English Language classes. Planning and organizing weekly meet-ups, oriented on the improvement of English learning skills (movie discussion sessions, book discussions, public lectures on different topics, etc.)

TERMS & CONDITIONS



1.Volunteer will receive 1 year unlimited transport card, pocket money + food allowance every month in the amount of 200 euro.

2. The volunteers travel costs from Belgium to Georgia (roundtrip) will be covered 100% if within the budget of the European SolidarityCorps program. (360 euro per volunteer)



3. Joetz will enroll the volunteers before departure trough the European health insurance card CIGNA

TERMS & CONDITIONS

4. Volunteer will be accommodated in a room (single or double) in rented flat with access to kitchen and bathroom. Flats are furnished and equipped with pillows, duvet covers, pillow cases and washing machine and fast Internet connection /Wi-Fi

5. Georgian Language Classes Volunteers will be provided with Georgian Language classes by private teacher.



6. ICPI organization provides with a mentor's support, who will help the volunteer set learning goals and together they may evaluate them after the project has finished. Also, the mentor can help the volunteer with emergency situations, such as going to the doctor.
